Jim Barisano is Chairman and CEO of WheelsTV. Jim's breakthrough television show was *Wild About Wheels*, the first automotive television series to air in prime-time on a national television network. This weekly series became a hit show on the Discovery Channel in 1990 where it aired for three years. It then helped launch the Speedvision Network and became an international sensation, airing in Japan, Russia and throughout Europe. Jim has since produced over 200 automotive television shows including *Motor Trend TV*, *Hot Rod TV*, *Dirt Rider Adventures* and the PBS documentary series, *WHEELS*.

Jim's first automotive video program covered the Newport Jaguar Festival in July of 1985 when the *Coventry Cat* was a newsletter and Peter Gould and Richard Mazur were co-presidents of the New England XK Association. Since then, Jim's

cameras have captured the action at most of the major racing and concours venues including Pebble Beach, Newport, Daytona, Sebring, Laguna Seca, Hilton Head, Amelia Island, Road Atlanta and Ford's 200+ mph proving grounds in Kingman, Arizona. Today, as the leading provider of video test drives and auto show coverage to MSN, AOL, Yahoo, AutoTrader, Cablevision and Time-Warner, WheelsTV continues to bring automotive excitement home to millions of viewers via IPTV, the Internet, on-demand and mobile devices. In addition to clips from programs spanning his career, Jim will provide highlights from the recent New York, Paris and Los Angeles shows featuring Jaguar, Rolls-Royce and Bentley.

Meeting John Fitch By Dave Randall



Editor's note: John Cooper Fitch, American racecar driver and inventor, passed away on October 31, 2012, at the age of 95. Fitch started racing after World War II and competed at Sebring, Le Mans, Buenos Aires and Italian Grand Prix races to name a few. He also rallied in the Alpine, Mille Miglia and Carrera Panamericana. He drove all sorts of cars from MG to Corvette and of course Jaguars.

The 1955 Le Mans disaster inspired Fitch to devote his efforts to motorsport safety. He invented several impact absorbing systems for use on track, in cars and on public roads and highways.

Fitch raced competitively even into his 80s and continued driving in vintage race events especially at Lime Rock Park, near where he lived at the time of his death.

I met and talked to John Fitch three memorable not sure if I could have kept up with him, late 80's at times.

The third time I met him, the venue was the Concours at Greenwich. A friend and I were about to purchase our tickets (\$20) to enter the show. We had arrived about 30-40 minutes earlier; however, it took us that long to get to the gate, because easily 50% of the show was in the parking lot looking at what people brought. That's where just about anything can be found from an old RR to TRs, MGS Lancias, NSU, Fiats, domestic stuff, Jaguars of course, some of the best to be seen have been driven there.

So there we were as this Jeep Wagoneer pulled up to the curb, and out came John Fitch and what appears to be a daughter and son-in-law or vise-versa. I said hello John, and the son (son-in-law) asked me if I could help with some of the stuff they brought, as I believe he was selling his book about driving for MB in 1955. So I said come on Bob (my friend) let's give them a hand, in fact I had to ask him twice to help, as he was a little slow on the uptake. I knew that no one would stop us if we were with John Fitch and sure enough we saw the rest of the show without buying a \$20 ticket! I love that guy.


The second time I met him was when Becky and I were at Pebble Beach in 2006. I was getting my photo taken with Phil Hill. Phil appeared to be rather frail, he was in a golf cart being brought around by some official. I asked for an autograph and was given a postcard of Phil and his XK120 in which he won the first Pebble Beach race in 1950. Anyway, as this all was taking place, along came John Fitch (almost running) he said a quick hello to Phil and me and he was off. I'm

the time and he was moving fast.

A little aside, the Phil Hill XK120 was in the Concours, and I spent some time with its now owner. There was, at the time a story about the car and the way it was discovered. Seems that even when this XK120 was found it still took some time before it was found to be Hill's car. And it was discovered by the then owner, not the first to locate it. Can you imagine?

The first time I met John Fitch was at Lime Rock. Autoweek made known that they had some tickets to a weekend event there, and if you gave them a good story/reason to go, they would bestow a pair. Well apparently I had a good story/reason as I got a pair, and my son Roger and I had a great time. Part of the deal was lunch. While we were having lunch John Fitch came in with a gentleman who I recognized but could not remember who he was. He and John were talking all during their lunch and though I wanted to meet John, I did not want to interrupt their conversation. At some point near the end of our meal the fellow (who I still could not recognize) must have had to go to the men's room. I jumped at this opportunity and went over and introduced myself and talked with John for a couple of minutes. I asked about his involvement with Briggs Cunningham and when he drove some Jaguars. And then as I was leaving I said I recognized the fellow he was talking with, but could not for life of me come up with who he was... He looked at me and said "I am in the same boat as you, I don't know who he is either!"

JCNA Annual Competition Awards

Click on View Current North American Standings.

If you are eligible to receive a competition award, please click on your score. A list of all of your scores for the current season are displayed. When the **Competition Award Confirmation** page is displayed, fill out all the information, then click the Submit button. **Do this by the middle of January**, as it takes JCNA a while to have the plaques made up and shipped out. If you plan to attend the AGM and want your award presented to you at the AGM, be sure to check the box above your name.

F-Type and XFR-S Debut at LA Auto Show

Jaguar introduced the all new F-Type to American audiences at the LA Auto Show in November. The aluminum bodied two-seat convertible is being touted as a true high performance sports car. The 2014 models will come in three flavors -- F-Type, F-Type S and F-Type V8 S and go on sale summer 2013.

Also on display in LA was the XFR-S, the "super size" version of the XFR. This model features all the XFR goodies plus a few extra upgrades. It will share the 8-speed transmission with "quickshift" found on the F-Type, 20" Varuna-style lightweight wheels, a special aerodynamic exterior package with rear deck spoiler and a 550HP V8 supercharged engine. Jag For All Seasons: The 2013 AWD XJ and XF

Development and Testing






