

I've truly enjoyed the job for the last four years and having the opportunity to work with the dedicated folks on the JANE Board of Directors. I've also enjoyed getting to know many of you better and learning more about your interests. I'm happy to report, however, that Howard Kalet will be taking over the job at the beginning of the New Year. I'd ask that all of you give Howard the same extraordinary level of support that I've enjoyed. While the Membership VP is responsible for maintaining liaison with JCNA, reporting membership numbers, processing renewals and new members, etc., it's really through the efforts of you, the general membership,

that the club continues to thrive and grow.

While JANE has enjoyed "bragging rights" as the largest JCNA-affiliated club in North America for the last three years, our membership has declined slightly since 2014, and I'm sorry to say that according to the JCNA Master Roster, at present, at 287 members, we're slightly behind the Sun Coast Jaguar Club of Florida in Tampa.
