


Holiday Party at the Vesper Country Club

Don't be reluctant to suggest a topic or share a tale of your own for one of our meetings. If there is something of interest to you, it could be interesting to others.




Ken Loring - 1947-2016

Ken enjoyed boating, motorcycling, and driving his classic cars around New England. He attended the Scituate Lighthouse Cruise-in very often, a short

drive from his dream garage located on the other side of town.

Many of us had the pleasure to spend time with Ken at his garage, on his boat, and at various car events. He always had a story to tell, and we all enjoyed his great smile and laugh. My brother and I purchased new Honda motorcycles in 1969 from Boston Cycles, and found out about ten years ago that Ken was the sales manager there at that time. Ken then went on to start Boston Interiors and successfully expanded that business to many locations. Ken raced motorcycles at the same time that my brother and I were actively riding enduros around New England, and we shared many of the same experiences, although in parallel without knowing each other. Ken always had a love of British motorcycles and drove Triumphs and Nortons his whole life, as well as many other makes.



Ken held a JANE event at his fantastic home a few years ago, and led a tour on the surrounding spectacular shore roads, followed by a cookout and tire kicking session. It was a beautiful day and many of us enjoyed it thoroughly. A tour of his garage was part of the day. Ken enjoyed explaining every detail about his cars, and all the calamities he experienced with each one. A day ending in a flatbed ride with his classic car did not bother him in the least, and the car would be running again the next day, problem solved.

We all enjoyed hanging out with Kenny, and he will always remain in our memories and life experiences. We all gained from his ever-positive attitude, and it was our collective pleasure to have been lucky enough to know him.




day guy, I got to know Al through these events and his frequent attendance at JANE's monthly meetings.



Help Wanted



** JCNA VOLUNTEER POSITION AVAILABLE **

Would you like to become more involved with JCNA and help grow its membership? Would you like to work with JCNA leadership and JCNA-affiliated clubs throughout North America? A high-visibility volunteer position is opening up that offers a rare opportunity to play a leading role at the national level in JCNA membership recruitment. The successful candidate will coordinate what is essentially a "matchmaker" service that helps potential JCNA members find a local club. The unofficial title of the position is the "JCNA Club Locator Service Coordinator."

Inquiries from potential new members come from two main sources:

- 1. Every Jaguar sold for the last several years has a "Passport to Service" packet, which includes warranty and maintenance information. The packet also contains a card that the owner can mail in to request information about local clubs and about joining JCNA.
- 2. The JCNA website has a link to an online form under the "Club List" tab, where potential members can request information about local clubs and JCNA.

Whether an inquiry comes in written or electronic format, the Coordinator responds with information about the closest club (or clubs) as well as information about JCNA membership benefits. The successful candidate should be familiar with word processing and basic spreadsheet functions (MS Word and Excel are preferred).

The Coordinator will also have the opportunity (if desired) to participate on the JCNA Membership Committee and to interact with the highest levels of JCNA leadership. The Coordinator will also work closely with Ed Avis to develop and maintain better outreach methods, databases, maps, and analytical tools.


